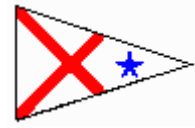

### 1. SCHEDULE

Final Registration and Parent Orientation will be Sunday June 23, 2013 @ 4:00pm. Attendance for a parent or guardian is required to go over last minute details, meet the Instructors and to learn any changes for this season. Just prior to this, Instructors will conduct a gear check and rigging clinic from 3:00 – 3:45, and immediately following the Parent Orientation will be the Junior Sailing BBQ.

A Calendar of important dates is attached with this packet. The calendar has program start/end dates, regatta dates, and dates the program will not be in session.

The program will begin Monday June 24<sup>TH</sup>. The Junior Olympics are July 22<sup>RD</sup> & 23<sup>TH</sup> and all sailors, except for beginners, are strongly encouraged to register and race. There will be a program Cup Race's throughout the season. The program will continue until Thursday, August 15<sup>TH</sup>. Awards will be Friday night, August 16<sup>TH</sup>.

### 2. FORMAT

The program is Monday through Thursday, 8:30am (Rigged) to 4pm each day. However, 1<sup>st</sup> year sailors (Greenies) will be in the morning from 8:00am to 12:30 pm. (Times for greenies may change– we will inform you at final registration)

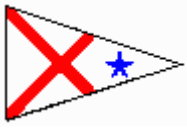

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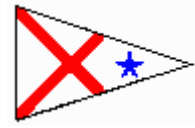

### 3. SIZE

The program will be limited to 65 sailors. Due to the individual instruction necessary, the Green Fleet will be limited to 12 per session. Limited facility size, the number of instructor's hired and the number of motorboats needed require that we limit the program. Our goal is to maintain a quality program for those children in the program.

### 4. PRE-REGISTRATION

There is a pre-registration process which is extremely important due to the proper hiring and oversight of the program. As indicated on the application, there will be a \$100.00 deposit due by May 20, 2013. This will allow for the sufficient time to address budgeting concerns. Please read the pre-registration policy written on the application form to avoid any potential misunderstandings. Balance of account will be due on June 23, 2013 or a \$50.00 late fee will be imposed. 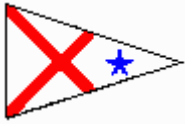
#### 4.1. Required Paperwork

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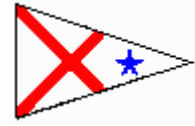

### 5. BOATS ARE MANDATORY (UNLESS A 420 CREW)

It has been determined that in the best interests of everyone in the program, all sailors should have a boat to sail from day one. Participation without a boat is unfair to the child, the instructors and to the other sailors. Parents/guardians will have to purchase, lease, rent, or borrow boats in order to fulfill this requirement.

### 6. DIVISIONING

Due to different interests and abilities of each child, the Junior Sailing Committee has decided to separate the program into various distinct divisions. All sailors must pass a basic swim test (no life jacket) on the first day of program.

#### 6.1. Beginner or Greenie Fleet

The Green fleet will focus on an introduction to sailing. The emphasis is on fundamentals, developing confidence around sailboats, understanding safety on the water and basic seamanship. The BBYRA has updated the guidelines for the Greenie Fleet and these may be reviewed at <http://www.bbyra.org/greenFleet.htm>. *NOTE: All Green Fleet sailors MUST have a bow bumper affixed to their boat at the beginning of program.*

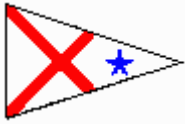
#### 6.2. Opti Silver Fleet

Will be for those sailors that have “graduated” from the Green Fleet. This fleet will emphasize participation rather than race results. Fun activities and basic drills will be incorporated into the class in order to foster a true a love sailing as an activity as well as a sport. Participation in Interclubs is optional; please speak with your Instructor if you wish your child to participate.

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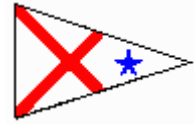

### 6.3. Opti Gold Fleet

This program is designed for the Opti sailor who enjoys some competition. Participation in Interclubs is expected as well as local regattas.

### 6.4. Opti A/Racing Fleet

This program is designed for sailors who truly enjoy competing and who will be racing in all bay area regattas and possibly some travel regattas. All travel expenses, including coaching, will be picked up by the participating sailors.

### 6.5. 420 Fleets

These fleets are intended for older, more experienced sailors. Advanced racing techniques and strategies will be focused on as well as the concepts and techniques of double handed sailing. Participation in Interclubs is expected. Participation in all bay area regattas is strongly encouraged.

**\*\*New for 2013\*\*** IHYC is combining the 420 program with the other local BBYRA Downbay clubs. The fleet will be hosted out of TRYC. This is the IHYC program and the kids will be representing IHYC. 420s may be kept at IHYC or TRYC (With Fee). There will be a launch provided to TRYC from IHYC in the morning at 8:00am and pickup will be at 4:00pm. Instructors will conduct chalk and other dry and activities at TRYC and participants may benefit from keeping their 420 at TRYC.

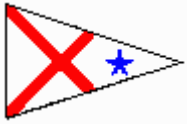
### 6.6. Changes to Divisions

*These categories may change based on registration!* The instructional staff will decide, based upon performance levels, which

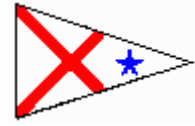

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division (with the exception of the Green Fleet) each sailor will participate in. Evaluations of all sailors will continually be done throughout the program to determine if they are capable of moving to a different division, if they wish to do so.

### 7. CUP RACES

The Cup Races are the inter-program races conducted throughout the program year which results are awarded at the end of season award banquet. To foster increased cohesion among the various age groups of juniors in the program and to expose the kids to the structure typically found outside of our program, the IHYC Junior program has made some changes to 2012 format of the CUP RACES and will continue with this format in 2013. All sailors will be encouraged to participate. Greenies will participate when it has been determined the fleet is ready by the Instructor.

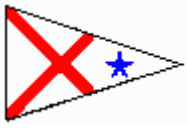
Tentatively... There will be a 8:45am Skippers meeting on Cup Race days followed by a 9am Harbor Start with a start to follow in ½ an hour. All fleets will sail on the same course. The starting sequence will have the Lasers, then 420's, followed by the Opti's. All Opti fleets start on same line. (*Optionally the Greenies may have their own start.*) All fleets will be in for a BBQ Lunch by noon. At 1pm there will be a harbor gun with a strat to follow in ½ an hour.

Scoring will be low point and will be posted on Jr Sailing Web Site and on Jr Board the same day. Opti's will be scored by Red 13+ / Blue 11-12 / White -10 / Green /and overall. All races will be scored no throwouts. Excused cuts allowed for outside regatta participation and will be scored average points.

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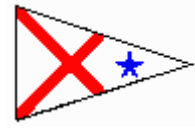

**Members Child: Must be 8yrs old by December 31, 2013 and not yet 18.**

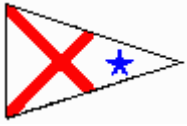
**Non-Member Child: Must be 8 yrs old by the start of the program or going into 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and not yet 18.**

a) We will limit the program to 65 sailors. Green Fleet will be limited to 12 sailors

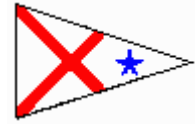

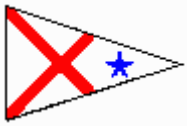


- b) If demand exceeds 65, priority will be given to members' children and existing non-member children in the program. Siblings of existing non-members will have priority over new non-members. After May 15<sup>th</sup>, if there are still spots available, priority will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- c) There will be pre-registration. A \$100 deposit per registered sailor is required by May 19, 2013 to reserve a spot. The balance is due by June 23, 2013.
- d) Included in this packet are the forms for "Statement of Parental Consent and Release from Liability", "Medical Consent" and "Sailor's Code of Conduct". These forms must be properly filled out and delivered before your child will be allowed to participate in the Program. Please mail to Brian Taboada at POB 526, Island Heights, NJ 08732
- e) The Laser Radial Travel Team is open but sailors must be vetted. Please contact Andrew Kraus ([afkraus@comcast.net](mailto:afkraus@comcast.net)) for more information. *(At this time the team may be full)*
- f) Families with 3 or more children in the program can pay half of the required deposit.
- g) Registration after June 23<sup>TH</sup> will only be accepted if there are less than 65 sailors pre-registered and requires an additional \$50 late fee.
- h) Pre-registration fees will only be refunded if the spot reserved for your child is filled.

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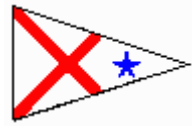

- i) All children registered MUST have their own boat, if not crewing in a 420. Parents/guardians will have to purchase, charter, or rent a boat.

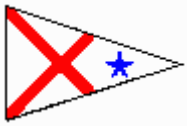

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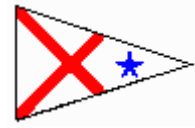

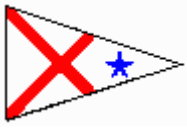
### 12. CLOTHING ORDERS

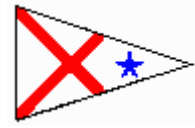

### 13. HOW TO REGISTER

\*\*The online registration has been re-configured this year for Member and Non-Member. Please read the instructions carefully.

After reading this packet, proceed to the calendar appointment for “Jr Sailing Registration” found on Sunday June 23, 2013.

#### 13.1. MEMBER Registration

Sailors may be registered online using the member registration fees if their parent, grandparent or guardian is a full IHYC member, or if the sailor is an Independent Junior Member. *Member rates will only be applied if the member logs into the web site with their username and password.*

NOTE #1: Remember that IHYC billing is linked to the primary family member, so please use the primary family member user credentials when registering so that the fees and balances are correctly assigned to your account and are displayed to you upon logging into the web site. The sailor's information will be collected after the primary member has logged in.

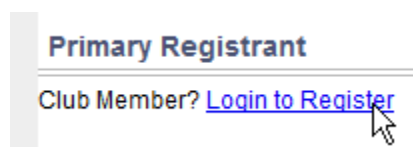
