

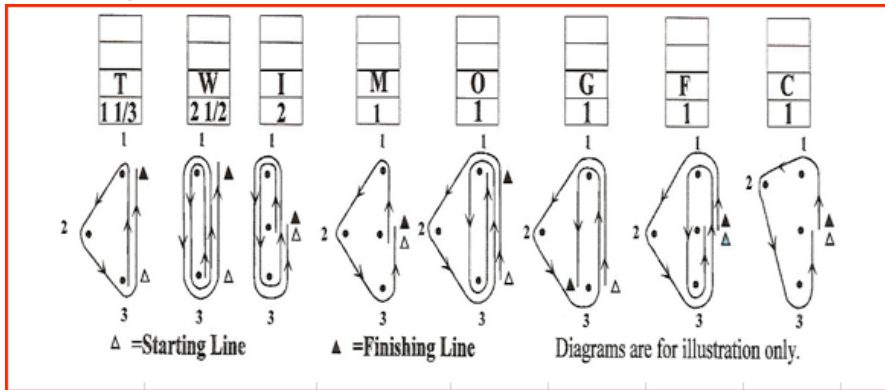
# **2018 JACOMO SAILING CLUB GRAND INVATIONAL REGATTA**

## **NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)**

- 1) **RACE DATE**  
2018 Jacomo Grand Invitational Regatta will be held Saturday August 4, 2018. Four races are scheduled, fleet racing, 3 like boats make a fleet. Odd boats racing handicap with Portsmouth Handicap scoring.
- 2) **RULES**  
All races will be sailed on Lake Jacomo. Races shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), as adopted by US Sailing and the Sailing Instructions.
- 3) **ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**  
Jacomo Sailing Club
- 4) **ELIGIBLE SKIPPERS**  
This event is open to any person club member or not, sailing their own or borrowed boat. This changes Chapter VIII of Jacomo Sailing Club by-laws.
- 5) **RC ASSIGNMENTS**  
The races are to be run by the Race Committee of the Day as assigned by the Jacomo Sailing Club and designated in the JSC "Sailing Instructions". The Race Committee shall record the starting and finishing times for all entrants.
- 6) **LAKE JACOMO REQUIREMENTS**  
All yachts must meet the requirements of the Jackson County Parks and Recreation Department as they apply. All yachts must have a Jackson County Lake License, single day license are \$25.00 and can be purchased at the marina.
- 7) **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**  
Skippers registration and meeting: West Side Pavilion 8:00 am with light breakfast.  
    First Race 10:00 am  
    Second, Third and Fourth Race: Shall immediately follow the previous race. Short break between Second and Third race for snack lunch provided. Target racing conclusion 4:00 pm.  
Social and awards presentation 5:00 pm, JSC Sailing Center 22103 Woods Chapel Rd. Blue Spring Mo 64015, food and refreshments provided.
- 8) **COURSES TO BE SAILED:**
  - A) **TYPES**
    - T = Triangle
    - W = Windward and leeward
    - I = Windward, leeward and windward, with start and finish in the middle of leg
    - M = Triangle with start and finish in middle of leg
    - O = Triangle followed by windward, leeward and windward (Olympic)
    - G = Triangle followed by windward and leeward (Gold Cup)
    - F = "O" with start and finish in the middle of the leg (modified Olympic)
    - C = Catamaran triangle with start and finish in the middle of the leg
  - B) **COURSE BOARD INFORMATION**  
You will see this information on the Race Committee course board: Red or Green plaque on the stern of the committee boat will indicate port or starboard mark rounding. Red leaves the mark to port, Green leaves the mark to starboard.  
First Box = Course Number, Second Box = Compass Heading to First Mark,  
Third Box = Course Diagram Signal, Fourth Box = Number of laps or partial laps.

### C) COURSES

All rounding marks are ORANGE BALL inflatables.

### 9) RACE INFORMATION

#### JSC Grand Invitational Regatta

This regatta is open to all sailors and yachts. It is designed to promote one design racing. All one design yacht are invited. Racers may use their own or a borrowed boat, this changes chapter VIII of Jacomo Sailing club by-law. Racers will be scored per their fleet and three like boats make a fleet. Odd boats will be combined into a Handicap fleet and will be scored using Portsmouth Handicapping. It will be at the PRO's discretion to set the course for each race, all fleets sail the same course and four races are planned. The PRO may combine fleets into a common start, however preference will be given to each fleet receiving their own start, up to a maximum of 6 starts. Fleet start code flag assignments will be announced at the skippers meeting. Please obtain this NOR from the public posting at the bulletin board, the club web site ([jacomosailingclub.org](http://jacomosailingclub.org)) or from the Regatta Chairman Mark Graham ([macforever@hotmail.com](mailto:macforever@hotmail.com)).

### 10) Registration and Fees

Please notify the race committee by July 25, 2018 of your intention to participate and what type of yacht you will be sailing. Registration fees are \$20.00 per boat if paid before July 25, 2018 or \$25.00 per boat on day of event 8:00 am skippers meeting, this is in addition to the one day County lake license fee for off lake yachts mentioned in # 6 of this NOR. ### 11) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available on the club bulletin board 7:30 am day of event, (club bulletin board located by the boat ramp near the north marina), on the Jacomo website ([jacomosailingclub.org](http://jacomosailingclub.org)), or from the Regatta Chairman Mark Graham ([macforever@hotmail.com](mailto:macforever@hotmail.com)) no later than August 1, 2018.

### 12) TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded one trophy per 3 boats, per fleet. Race results will be posted in the normal club procedure, on the club website ([Jacomosailingclub.org](http://Jacomosailingclub.org)). Trophies will be awarded during the social at the conclusion of racing that day. This changes Chapter X of the Jacomo Sailing Club by-laws.

### 13) SCORING

Scoring will be low point system, appendix A of the current RRS with the following exceptions. Finish in Place

**(FNP) = # of starters. This changes RRS A4.1, A4.2 and A11. Ties will be broken using Appendix A.8 of the current RRS. One race must be completed to constitute an event. All races sailed will count.**
