The City of Fort Lauderdale is seeking a **Certified Floodplain Management (CFM)** candidate who has specialized knowledge of the **Community Rating System (CRS)**. This ideal candidate is someone who can not only review and analyze plans to determine compliance with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), City of Fort Lauderdale Building and Zoning Ordinances, the Florida Building Code, and related technical codes, but someone who can take the **lead role in coordinating the City's Community Rating System (CRS)** activities with FEMA and the Insurance Services Office.

The successful candidate will ensure that the City meets required responsibilities in order to maintain and improve the City's classification and flood insurance discount in the program. The CRS Specialist will report to the Floodplain Manager, and is expected to make independent decisions and judgments on Floodplain Management and CRS issues. They will also perform plan review as a **Floodplain Development Review Specialist** and apply for and coordinate grant activity.

Minimum requirements include an Associate's Degree and one year of Floodplain Management/CRS experience. **Certification as a Floodplain Manager (CFM)** is also required.
