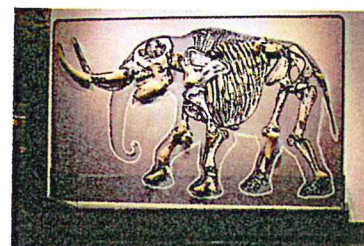

Daytona Beach Stormwater Parks and Museum of Arts and Sciences Tours

During this morning tour, you will explore Daytona Beach's premier stormwater parks and the Smithsonian-affiliated Museum of Arts and Sciences. Your morning will begin with a guided walk-and-talk about the working park designed to enhance the surrounding neighborhood and provide flood mitigation. This is also the site where mastodon bones were unearthed during construction. Following the tour of the parks, participants will visit Daytona Beach's unique Museum of Arts and Sciences with one the largest displays of Coca-Cola memorabilia in the world, full-size trains, a natural history wing, a planetarium and fine art.
