Course Description

To open the workshop, and to prepare the attendees for a more in-depth discussion of the issues, a basic foundation of the NFIP, its structure, administration, and benefits will be presented. Additionally, basic components of the concept of SI/SD will be presented. The course will then move directly into FEMA's Substantial Improvement/ Substantial Damage Desk Reference and discussion will be drawn directly from the Manual.
