This course is for community officials with a CFM designation or 2 years of full-time floodplain management experience as a community official. Participants should have completed the *Managing Floodplain Development through the NFIP* course.



Course Description

The full four-day course includes an in-depth discussion of the roles and responsibilities of the local Floodplain Manager, the NFIP floodplain rules and regulations, the procedures for applying for a FEMA Letter of Map Change and the floodplain management implications, and preparing for post-disaster responsibilities.

G-194.3: This module explores the floodplain management implications of LOMCs for the local floodplain administrator. Activities include a review of LOMC types, proposed development scenarios, local considerations and responsibilities in signing a Community Acknowledgement Form, opportunities to promote best practices, and review of sample ordinance language to manage floodplains and provide enforcement authority at the local level.
