Course Description

The full four-day course includes an in-depth discussion of the roles and responsibilities of the local Floodplain Manager, the NFIP floodplain rules and regulations, the procedures for applying for a FEMA Letter of Map Change and the floodplain management implications, and preparing for post-disaster responsibilities.

G-194.4: The scope of this module includes an introduction to pre- and post-disaster planning as well as an introduction to post-disaster operations. Participants learn how to identify partners and resources, create a post-disaster SOP, manage public information campaigns, conduct detailed substantial damage inspections, handle substantial damage declarations and posting, manage permitting, documentation, and compliance, and access potential funding sources.
