Course Description

This four-day course includes an in-depth discussion of the NFIP floodplain rules and regulations, the procedures for applying for a FEMA Letter of Map Change and the floodplain management implications, the roles and responsibilities of the local Floodplain Manager, and preparing for post-disaster responsibilities.

Each of these topics is designed to be at a higher level of detail than any basic course. Developed and real-life scenarios will be examined and exercises will be conducted in each section to make sure participants not only understand the appropriate rules and regulations, but also why they are in effect and how to apply them. This course is exercise rich and participants can expect to be engaged throughout much of the course.
