This four-day Intensive course is designed to teach Balint Group leadership technique primarily through experiential groups, supplemented by topic-focused small discussion groups and faculty panel discussions. Participants will have ample time to present cases, practice leading a Balint Group, and engage informally with other participants. Faculty-guided de-brief sessions provide participants opportunities to receive feedback on their practice sessions in a safe and supportive setting.

PLEASE NOTE: Participants should be clinically active and willing to present a case. It is important to participate in the entire program. Success of the conference depends on group cohesiveness. Please do not plan to arrive late, leave early, or miss sessions.
