Healing Relationships: Challenges & Inspirations

Bring us up to date on your research and scholarly insights. For example: What relationships need healing? What helps? When do relationships heal us? What parts do challenge and inspiration play in that? How is diversity involved in the challenges or inspirations of healing relationships? What can we learn about the Balint method from challenges you have met in your setting or within your group(s)? What evidence do you see that Balint groups themselves are inspiring? Where do we need to develop/invent new ways to handle new issues or populations or settings?

The time for each presentation is a maximum of 20 minutes (15 minutes for the paper and 5 minutes of audience discussion). You need not be an ABS member to submit. Authors are expected to attend the meeting to present their work.

A 100 to 300 word abstract of the full text of your paper must be received by March 15, 2018 to be considered.

Abstracts:

- submit these electronically, in English by email only (Word (.doc or .docx) or .rtf format).
- include two pages, the title page with author(s) identified and the abstract page with no author information.
- for the presenting author include a name, degree, institutional affiliation, if any, city, country, email address

You will receive an email acknowledging the receipt of your abstract within 2 weeks after submission. We will notify you of the status of your submission as soon as we finish our review.
