- Award submission forms will be posted as of September 1 of each year and will be available on the Colorado Snowmobile Association website. <http://www.snowmobilecolo.com/>
- Supporting documents, pictures, testimonials, etc. should be presented as an attachment.

- Applications to be reviewed and award recipients will be chosen by the sitting past two CSA Presidents and the Awards / Scholarship Committee members.
 - CSA Awards to be presented at the Annual CSA Convention (January of each year)
 - All CSA Award Recipients will be submitted to the American Council of Snowmobile Associations (ACSA) by April 15 of the year of nomination. Winning recipients will be notified in early May of their selection. Awards will be presented at the International Snowmobile Congress in June. The Club of the Year will be submitted to the International Snowmobile Hall of Fame for the International Snowmobile Club of the Year award.
