

The National Board of the ROCKS, Inc. **2021 LTG Edward Honor Scholarship Award**



The late LTG Edward Honor's career in the U.S. Army spanned 35 years in the Transportation Corps and the logistics field. Subsequent to his military career he served as President of the National Defense Transportation Association (NDTA) for 13 years.

Born in Melville, Louisiana and a graduate of George Washington Carver High School, he immediately entered Southern University and A&M College. He earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Education and was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant in 1954. His military education includes: Armor Officers Basic Course; Transportation Orientation and Advanced Courses; the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College; and the U.S. Army War College. General Honor served at the highest levels of command and staff to include Director of Army Transportation, Commander Military Traffic Management Command and Director of

Logistics Joint Chiefs of Staff. His achievements in these assignments were numerous. The other area which he will always be remembered will be the mentoring of Soldiers whether they were a General Officer or Junior Enlisted. His leadership ensured the ROCKS will continue to be the preeminent mentoring organization in our Armed Forces.

On September 3, 2008, LTG Honor passed away. He was the quiet catalyst that propelled the ROCKS organization over the past years. To honor his legacy The National Board of the ROCKS, Inc. has established a Leadership Award recognizing our most outstanding graduating college seniors who demonstrate superior leadership skills, exceptional scholarship, and outstanding ability to mentor. The selectees will receive a \$2,000.00 stipend, recognition at the ROCKS Annual Spring Gala and Awards Ceremony and their name will be placed on a perpetual LTG Edward Honor trophy.
