Park Slope Charges into the Future

On June 21, 2021 Con Edison will begin construction for the installation of an Electric Vehicle Curbside Charger Location on Prospect Park West between 5th St and 6th St. The multiple-vehicle charger at this location is scheduled to be operable on July 27, 2021 (pending construction completion).

The charger location is part of a city-wide project, in partnership with New York City Department of Transportation and the FLO Network, to install over 100 curbside electric vehicle charging ports across New York City. The charger location on Marcus Garvey Blvd will host 2 chargers for electric vehicles.

What is a Curbside Charger?

These are electric vehicle chargers that are accessible for public curbside parking. There will be 2 parking spaces adjacent to the chargers on Prospect Park West dedicated to electric vehicles. All existing parking regulations will remain in effect for each parking site.

Benefits of Curbside Charger Locations:

Public curbside charger locations attract more consumers to places of business by offering a charging option in addition to parking and increase the value and attractiveness of residential buildings for renters and owners who park their electric vehicles on the street and need to charge close to home.

Creating an infrastructure of electric vehicle charger locations is crucial to the ability to expand the number of electric vehicles on the road. As the number of electric vehicles on the road increases, New Yorkers get the benefit of reduced toxic tailpipe emissions that contribute to smog and climate change. We will have cleaner air and water and better health.

Electric vehicles have ranges of up to 300 miles on a single charge. The average New Yorker travels less than 20 miles a day, so electric vehicles can easily go the distance.

We are quite excited about this new program, as we begin to build a new robust greener infrastructure for the future. We invite you to share this information with your network, to help spread the word.
