4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a four-year college/university
5. Must have demonstrated a high level on academic excellence.
6. An official sealed high school transcript
7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
8. A **completed** Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Community Service:

1. Graduating senior.
2. GPA 2.5 or above
3. Two Letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from a teacher/school counselor
 - b. One from a member of the community
4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a two- or four-year college/university
5. Must have demonstrated merit in the community service /volunteerism
6. An official sealed high school transcript
7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
8. A **completed** Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Perseverance:

1. Graduating senior.
2. GPA 2.0 or above
3. Two Letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from a teacher/school counselor
 - b. One from a member of the community
4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a two- or four-year college/university
5. Must have demonstrated overcoming hardship/adversity.
6. An official sealed high school transcript
7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
8. A **completed** Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Applicants may apply to each category, however may only be awarded one scholarship.
