## Green Neighbors

---

Green Neighbors is an evolving group of local residents largely from Cabin John and Carderock Springs who want to engage in community solutions to environmental problems. Since the Metal Recycling Challenge, residents have continued the new habit of recycling metals at a rate of over 200 pounds per week, the main location is an outside bin at the Bethesda Co-Op. In addition, you can continue to place your waste metals at two homes in Carderock, at 7604 Hamilton Spring Road and smaller items at 8027 Fenway Road. You can always contact the county at 240-777-6410 the day prior to our normal trash day for a special pick-up of appliances, fencing, or anything too large to fit in a trashcan.

Green Neighbors met in October and in November to plan our latest initiative of No More Plastic Bags in Cabin John businesses along MacArthur Boulevard. On November 15 Diane Karlik collected a bunch of hazardous waste materials to bring to the special collection at a satellite station at Westland MS, part of our participation in "America Recycles Day". Please remember that fluorescent bulbs of any type (the new compacts as well as traditional tubes), batteries other than alkaline batteries, oil-based paints, thermometers with mercury, toxic automotive liquids, herbicides, pesticides and toxic solvents should not be put out with the regular trash. They may be brought to the Solid Waste station on Route 355 and Shady Grove Road (16101 Frederick Road) - it is open 7 days a week, 9-5 pm. At this time, you can also contact [dianekarlik@verizon.net](mailto:dianekarlik@verizon.net) to deliver such items to her home and she can deliver them to Solid Waste. Please do not drop off as with metals, but wrap them well and contact her first to arrange this.

Did you know that the county recycles clothing and textiles at that same Shady Grove Road transfer station? Check their web site and their "Use it again database" ([www.montgomerycountymd.gov/useitagain](http://www.montgomerycountymd.gov/useitagain)) and search over 30 categories for local businesses or organizations that will take used goods for repair or reuse. Some even pick-up at your home.

Also consider joining BCC freecycle ([freecycle-bcc-md-subscribe@yahoogroups.com](mailto:freecycle-bcc-md-subscribe@yahoogroups.com)) to offer and/or receive a variety of items that individuals no longer use. More residents are also freecycling via our CS-Chat email list, which is another resource for neighborly cooperation and communication.

As of July 2008, residents can now recycle plastic curbside in blue bins and it's not only narrow-neck plastic bottles, but also almost all plastic bottles, containers and plastic lids. New items include bottles and plastic caps for syrup, detergent, shampoo, margarine, yogurt, peanut butter, etc. and pails or buckets for pet food and detergent, plastic flower pots and plastic cups. Not accepted in blue bins: STYROFOAM, PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC WRAP, HINGED CLAMSHELL PACKAGING for such items as berries and other fruits and PLASTIC CONTAINERS THAT CONTAINED HAZARDOUS MATERIALS such as garden or automotive products.
