## Junior Tennis Program SUMMER 2009

### Tournament Training (Advanced Clinic):

This clinic is designed for the tournament player. Each clinic will include a warm-up, specialized drilling (live-ball), match play, and intense fitness. My method of conducting the Tournament Training Program has led to many juniors becoming highly ranked in both the section and the nation. Juniors must be actively participating in Mid-Atlantic Tournaments in order to join.

### Players on the Rise (Intermediate Clinic):

Perfect clinic for junior players whose goal is to become a tournament player, or a more serious player. Each clinic will include a short warm-up, drills (fed-ball), match play and fitness. This program will help develop a more consistent player through repetition and specialized instruction.

### Up and Comers (Beginners/Low Intermediate):

Clinic is designed to develop proper technique as well as the understanding of the game of tennis. Clinic will include an abbreviated warm-up, stroke specific drilling, and games. Through this program student will gain a solid base for future development as well as an understanding for how to keep score and play matches.

### Tiny-Tots (Kids ages 4-7):

Introductory clinic, designed to develop motor skills and cognitive learning. Focus will be on hand-eye coordination, basic stroke technique, and enhancing each child's interest in the game of tennis. This is the perfect program for a young beginner to start the game of tennis and create an interest that will last a lifetime.

### BYOB Kick-Off Celebration

May 31, Sunday, 2- 5 pm

- Bring the whole family to Bring Your Own Bag for educational fun, food, and community spirit! Get your custom-designed unique reusable shopping tote made in the USA from recycled plastic bottles with your donation of \$3 -- say "NO" to plastic. Recycle Man duels Plastic Man - see who wins! Event held rain or shine, meet in the parking lot of the old firehouse building, MacArthur Blvd & 7 Locks Road.

Why: We must change our shopping habits to reduce plastic consumption. The average plastic bag is used for 12 minutes yet remains in our environment practically forever, impacting marine life and entering our food chain -- as evidenced by the enormous, growing plastic 'garbage patches' in the oceans. Plastics are increasing their presence in our own watersheds. Over 350 lbs of plastic bags and trash were collected in 3 recent cleanups in Minnehaha Creek along Goldsboro Road.

### Upcoming Events:

- June 7, noon to 4 pm. satellite electronics pick-up at BCC High School . Recycle your old TVs and outdated electronics. Last year, we collected almost 100,000 pounds of e-waste at Walt Whitman. Let's do even better this time. Volunteers will pass out free Honest Tea. All you need to do is gather up your stuff and drop on by. You don't even have to get out of your car.
- June 13 satellite toxic/hazardous waste pick-up at Westland MS
- June 13, 9 to noon. Grateful Shred, Clara Barton Community Center. Shredding party to avoid fraud or identity theft—and clean out your files *securely*. Like last year, ALL-SHRED, a noted firm in Frederick, MD, is providing a mobile shredding truck. Inside the truck is a cross-cut shredder that cuts your pages—while you watch--into tiny paper chips, which are then baled and sent to paper plants for recycling. (Or, if you wish, you may drop off material to shred, starting at 8 am.) Requested donation (voluntary): \$5 per box of paper (a one-cubic-foot storage box or the equivalent). Paper bags are OK containers. The following can be shredded along with office paper: staples, paper clips, rubber bands, folders, binder clips, hanging folders (even with metal strips), and labels. But not newspapers, 3-ring binders, cardboard, heavy plastic, heavy metals, boxes, trash, floppy disks, or CDs. All proceeds go to support activities at the Clara Barton Community Center, which is a facility of the Montgomery County Department of Recreation.
