JAY STEDMAN MEMORIAL GARDEN

We say a fond farewell to the Carderock Springs Garden Club, but not to the garden! Our Garden is located in the circle at the entrance to the Club on Hamilton Spring Ct.

The Garden Club started around 1984 with \$5 dues per year and about twenty members. Throughout the years we visited many interesting places like Brookside Gardens, Pleasant Sheep and Herb Farm in Boyds, Kiparoo Farm in Poolesville, and the Herb and Dried Flower Farm in Damascus. We also enjoyed the Sugarloaf Heritage Guild Autumn Studio Tour.



In 1997, the Garden Club dedicated the Garden to Jay Stedman: an early member, master gardener, and horticulturist. Many Carderock neighbors have donated their money, plants, and green thumbs to maintain the Garden. Martha Donnelly designed the original plan. Peter Hazell installed an ironwork bench and created the dry bed stream surrounding it. His wife Joan was the president for many years. Another past president was Brenda Bell, sister of Edmund Bennett, the developer and builder of Carderock Springs.

This fall, we purchased a plaque naming the Jay Stedman Memorial Garden. The plaque sits on a rock donated by Tri State Stone Co on Seven Locks. Nancy Everett and others did a major clean up.
