Veterinary /Health Requirements

Health Certificate required for horses traveling from out of state within 30 days of event. Coggins within one year required for all entries. A copy of Equine Flu Vaccine & Equine Herpes Virus records within 6 months must be sent with entry. If no immunization records are received. Entry will NOT be allowed to compete.

Stabling Information

permanent stalls with doors.
Each equine must have a stall. No working from trailer allowed.

Conditions (of above)

Competitors sharing equipment or drivers competing twice must be in different divisions and list on entry or notify before closing date. Organizers reserve the right to limit number of times around depending on the number of entries.

Misc. Show Info

General Information: Slow Moving Vehicle signs are required. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH. All competitors should read and follow current local, state and ADS COVID guidelines applicable during dates of the competition. Fans are allowed in barns but no appliances. Golf carts in limited numbers available and must be reserved and paid for at time of entry. SEPARATE CHECK required. 2 person is \$250, 4 person is \$275. Limited number available. Cones Comments: Cones will directly follow dressage with the competitor allowed a short time to use practice cones at the judge's discretion. They will be run in a timely manner. A groom is highly recommended for cones. If a turnout with a marathon carriage doesn't have a place for a groom, they will be allowed to stand as long as they remain still and are not moving the carriage.

Ribbons awarded for each division 1-6 places. Championship ribbon for Training, Preliminary and Intermediate.
