Veterinary /Health Requirements

Negative Coggins required within one year of competition. Flu and Rhino vaccinations required within 6 months in accordance with USEF GR845, and ADS Article 6.3. A health certificate is required by state of NJ for all out of state horses/ponies.

Stabling Information

Permanent stalls, board and chain link, full doors. No straw allowed! Bedding not provided. Shavings available for \$10 a bale. Contact Secretary if you need to purchase shavings or hay. Must be purchased prior to event! Early arrival requests must be made in writing to the event secretary, and will be honored based on availability.

Training only: Safety Checklist due at wheel measurement before dressage. Athletes and Horses must be registered with the USEF to compete for USEF National Championship titles. Athletes must be QUALIFIED U.S. citizens to compete for USEF National Championship titles. Those who are not qualified or do not wish to compete in the USEF Intermediate National Championship will compete in the same class, and will be awarded ribbons 1st-6th place, but will not be eligible for USEF National Championship prizes.

Awards Offered

All classes will be awarded prizes and ribbons 1st-6th place. Division Awards: Best Dressage, Best Marathon. USEF Intermediate National Combined Driving Championships: USEF Ribbons 1st-6th place, USEF Champion Cooler and Frame, USEF gold, silver, and bronze medals. Other awards include: Best Presentation, Ruthie Mulvey Sportsmanship award, Mark Borkoski Perpetual Best Overall Dressage award.
