

NEW VOTING OPTIONS

Beginning in 2020, ALL Pennsylvania voters have 3 options.

OPTION 1: TRADITIONAL IN-PERSON VOTING



This is a familiar option for Pennsylvanians, and until this year, was the only option available to voters without an approved reason to vote absentee.

- **WHERE?** At Your POLLING PLACE
- **WHEN?** On ELECTION DAY, between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.

OPTION 2: MAIL-IN and ABSENTEE VOTING



All registered voters are eligible to vote using a mail-in ballot. No reason is needed. Voters may choose this option because they will be away from home, are ill, or simply because it is their preference.

- **WHERE?** At Your HOME or temporary residence
- **WHEN?** Apply when the application process opens.
- **RETURN deadline** -- Your ballot must be **RECEIVED** by the Elections Division on Election Day.



Be an early bird! Apply and return your ballot early to avoid missing deadlines!

OPTION 3: "OVER-THE-COUNTER" VOTING



Wait...
What?!?

This new option is basically mail-in voting, minus the mail! You may appear in person at the County Elections Office, or County Satellite Office, to **request, mark, and submit your ballot all in the same visit**. It functions as a form of **early, in-person voting**. You will need to provide ID. This option is NOT available if you have already requested a mail-in ballot.

- **WHERE?** At the COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE:
- **OR** At a temporary County Satellite Office
- **WHEN?** Any time during office hours, 3-4 weeks before the election, once ballots are available.

WHAT IF...

YOU MAY...

- The Elections Office sent me a ballot, but it never arrived, or I **lost** it.

- I received my mail-in ballot, but it's **too late to mail** it back on time.

- **Vote at your polling place on Election Day** using a provisional ballot.

- **Deliver it to the County Elections Office in person.**
- **Return the ballot and barcoded envelope at your polling place on Election Day.** You will be permitted to vote using a regular ballot.
