



Get Ready to Vote: PA Municipal Election

November 2, 2021, 7 am – 8 pm



Who Is Eligible to Vote?

- All US citizens age 18 or older as of November 2, 2021
- PA residents for 30 days prior to November 2, 2021

Register by October 18 to Vote in the Municipal Election.

Register online at [VotesPA.com](https://www.votespa.com) using your PA driver's license, PennDOT ID or Social Security #. Printed registration forms can be downloaded from the website, or requested from your local county elections office*. Check your voter registration status at [VotesPA.com](https://www.votespa.com).

To Vote by Absentee or Mail-in Ballot:



- **Apply** online or download printed form at [VotesPA.com](https://www.votespa.com), or request one from your local county elections office*. **DEADLINE OCTOBER 26** for receipt by your elections office*.
- **Complete and mail your ballot:** Place your ballot in the secrecy envelope, seal it, and place it into official envelope. Don't forget to **sign and date the declaration** on the back of the official ballot envelope and **seal it**. **DEADLINE NOVEMBER 2** for receipt by your elections office*. Postmarks do not count.

To Vote In-Person:

Polls are open from 7am-8pm on Election Day, November 2. Bring voter registration card or another valid ID. Don't leave without voting. You may request a provisional ballot.

Remember These Important Deadlines:

(If mailing, add time. Postmarks do not count!)

- **October 18:** Last day to register to vote.
- **October 26:** Last day to apply for mail-in or absentee ballot.
- **November 2:** Election Day. Mail-in or absentee ballots to be received by 8pm.
