AFP SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

We acknowledge that one of our primary goals of this association is education for our members and their family. We also acknowledge the need for qualified employees in the field of Treasury, Banking, Finance, and Accounting. These opportunities will largely be filled from graduating students of our area schools, colleges and universities. We hope the scholarships will prove to be an investment in the field of Treasury and Finance in the Dallas/Fort Worth area by providing promising professionals with some financial assistance while completing their studies. The Fort Worth Chapter of the Association of Financial Professional (Ft. Worth AFP) has established a scholarship program to award scholarships to qualified candidates.

Previous recipients are eligible to re-apply in any semester that they qualify, but a new application must be submitted each time.

No scholarships will be granted for summer only or abbreviated semesters.

The applicant must satisfy the requirements below in order to be considered for the scholarship:

General Eligibility Criteria For the Scholarship

1. Demonstrate a relationship with the Fort Worth AFP via an application.
2. Conditions and Restrictions: The scholarship committee reserves the right to deny any applicant if they feel they do not meet the internal requirements of the program. Scholarships are limited to the amount and number by a decision of the Board on a yearly basis. All Applicants will be considered equally without regard for race, creed, religion, ethnicity or sexual orientation.

Academic Scholarship Criteria

1. Be a graduate from a Dallas/Fort Worth area high school or attending an accredited college or university and be a child of a Fort Worth AFP Member or a member of the Fort Worth Association of Financial Professionals, if the application is for the CTP examination.
2. Have maintained a grade point average of 3.00 or higher on a 4.00 scale (if currently attending college or university).
3. Preference will be given to candidates that are majoring in Accounting or Finance; however candidates in other related fields of study may still be considered for a scholarship award based on the Board's review and their recommendation.

4. Must have completed at least entry level accounting, finance, business or related classes in college or be expected to complete courses in this area within the next two years.

5. Scholarships are awarded one a year during the fall. Scholarship applications should be received no later than May 30th each year. Awards will be presented in June or July of each year.

6. Scholarships awards will be between: \$500 to \$2,500, unless the Board votes to change the amount.

7. All checks will be payable to the College or University for benefit of the Student, CTP fees will be reimbursed to the individual once receipt is provided for exam costs. No payment will be made directly to the student applicant.

8. The scholarship award may be used for tuition, exam fees, books, education fees and/or other direct educational expenses.

9. The Fort Worth AFP Board may change the program, the amount or qualification for the award of this scholarship without prior notice. The decision of the Fort Worth AFP Board is final and is not subject to external arbitration or other relief.
