You are invited to submit an application to the Rotary Club of Oak Park and River Forest for a Community Service Grant. The application for the Community Service Grant through the Rotary Club of Oak Park and River Forest is now available on our website: <http://www.oprfrotary.org/> on the left hand side of the home page.

If you would like to be considered for a grant, please submit the attached application by **March 9th**. Applications submitted after that date will not be considered for a grant in 2017.

Rotary International has adopted the following focus areas that will be considered as the grant applications are being reviewed:

- Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution
- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Water and Sanitation
- Maternal and Child Health
- Basic Education and Literacy
- Economic and Community Development  
(This Year the Rotary Club of Oak Park/ River Forest has a focus on reducing the incidence of and the impact from domestic violence. Grant applications for projects with such focus will be favorably considered.)

The grant application should be for a specific project that will benefit the Oak Park, River Forest and Forest Park community and/or neighboring communities such as the Austin Neighborhood, Maywood, Galewood Neighborhood or Berwyn. We have modified the range of grants available to be between \$2,500.00 and \$5,000.00.

Applications should be submitted via e-mail. You will receive email confirmation once the application is received. If you don't receive a confirmation, please contact Jim Lencioni.

Recipient awards will be delivered in the late spring of 2017 at the Club's Annual Recognition Breakfast. Recipient organizations are requested to have an individual on hand at the event to publicly accept the award.

Recipients are required to provide a grant report by December 31, 2017, demonstrating that (a) The project has been completed, including a description of the project's outcome; and (b) Rotary has been acknowledged as a donor to the organization on the donor's website, and promotional material specific to the funded project. In addition, we encourage participation in our annual fund raiser, the Rotary Rally to be held in late August. We use the funds raised at the rally to support our community grants.

A funded project must be for the funding of a specific activity or project rather than to make up general operating deficiencies.

Government organizations supported by local taxpayers will generally not be funded.

Priority will be given to projects that support the greatest number of residents in the areas noted above.

Applications must be sponsored by a current member in good-standing of the Rotary Club of Oak Park and River Forest.

**Important note:** If you received a grant in 2016, you are required to provide a grant report by February 15th, demonstrating that the funded project or activity has been completed. We have received many of the reports, but some are still outstanding. Grant recipients who do not complete a report for 2016 will not be considered for 2017.

Please review the application carefully and complete it as set forth in the guidelines and instructions. To facilitate completion, the application is in Word, and can be submitted in Word. Please submit the grant application via e-mail no later than **March 9th, 2017**. I will send you confirmation of receipt once I receive the grant.

Be sure to include your Rotarian sponsor's acknowledgement that s/he is sponsoring the request. That acknowledgement can also be sent via email to me along with your application.
