

Northeastern Regional Chapter Golf Outing

NERC held a fundraising golf outing on Wednesday, May 3 at Belham Split Rock Golf Courses in Bronx, NY.



It was a beautiful day, which was not too cold and not too hot, just perfect to play golf. Joined the fundraising event were 82 players, 10 volunteers and several businesses donated either funds or gifts.

Mrs. Joann Lee, president of NERC, decided to hold the golf outing one month earlier than last year and moved the golf course to the one in Bronx from the previous one in Long Island in order to invite more people to be able to attend, and it seemed to have worked as the number of players were 14 more than that of last year.

President Lee especially appreciated many senior Korean Americans who came and played golf, one of whom was Mrs. Lucy Oh, who was 80 years old, the oldest player of the outing. She also thanked Mr. Soo Cheon Kwak, who donated the round air ticket to Korea, which he had been presented as the winner of the Closest Ball Contest.

It was also successful in terms of the amount of funds raised.

The total revenue from the event was \$34,310, while the total expenses were \$8,794, resulting in the net income of \$25,516, which was about \$1,700 more than last year. Our golf outing event was referred a few times in the Korean Channel and the Korean Times, thus publicizing not only a fundraiser golf outing but also our organization, KASF.
