



## **“ART BY POETRY” COMPETITION**

### **GUIDELINES**

Artists have the responsibility to find a written work that inspires them to create their artwork. This can include, but is not limited to, working with a writer friend, finding an inspirational classic work or quoting something cute a young relative said or wrote the other day.

It is the responsibility of the contributing artist to ensure no copyright rules have been violated. The artist's signature confirming this is required on the entry form.

Awards, ribbons or monetary stipends will be awarded to the artist and will not be presented for any written work. The written work will be expected to enhance the artwork but will not be judged separately.

All written work presented shall be on an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper and, if typed, shall be in 24 point type, minimum.

Written work will be mounted, by the VVAA, on a poster board frame with an 8” x 10” window. Text must be arranged to fit in that window.

Written work shall be included with any exhibited artwork sold by the gallery. The artwork is for sale but the inspirational written work is not for sale. The inspirational work, however, will be offered with any with art sold after being removed from the poster board frame.
