\_\_\_\_\_ August 14: Kinetic art- Influenced by her background in kinesiology and biomechanics, Lynn Maguire talks to students about how she sees shapes, values and movement. (pastels)

\_\_\_\_\_ September 18: Tools and Transportation: Elspeth Kuta talks about early tools and transportation used in the Valley. Students make adobe bricks and/or create Plein Air paintings on the museum grounds. (acrylic)

\_\_\_\_\_ Oct. 23: Holiday Celebrations: Elspeth Kuta discusses holiday celebrations in the Valley. Students create their own toys and gifts. (recycle art)
