

## NFBC CHARITY RIDE TEAM RULES

We encourage club members to contribute and raise money for charity cycling events by joining our Charity Ride Team. All Participants must be an NFBC member in good standing to be on the team. All monies contributed or raised will be associated with the **North Florida Bicycle Club** and the individual fundraiser.

Before the start of each club mileage year, the Board of Directors approves the Charity Ride Team Captain. The Captain selects the charity events and submits them for board approval. Any changes to the NFBC Charity Ride Team requirements will be submitted and approved at the beginning of the club mileage year. Once approved, no changes will be made until the next year. The Team Captain may select a limited number of training rides associated with the approved charity rides. Training rides designated by the Charity Ride Team Captain do not require specific Board approval.

### **NFBC CHARITY TEAM MILEAGE AND POINTS ELIGIBILITY:**

- Members must join on the NFBC team by contacting the Team Captain prior to the event, not on the day of the event.
- Members must register themselves for the event as part of the NFBC team.
- Participating members must wear an NFBC jersey during the event.\*
- Participating members must wear an NFBC jersey during training rides.\*
- Participating members must sign the ride sheet or waiver supplied by the sponsoring organization.

Participating members must sign the [Charity Ride Team sheet](#) for all charity rides and any training rides not sponsored by NFBC.

### **\*EXCEPTIONS:**

- Team member has ordered a jersey and is awaiting delivery
- Jersey ordering window has not opened up for the team member since becoming an NFBC member or joining the Charity Ride Team **Note: Members who fail to wear an NFBC jersey by year's end will forfeit all charity ride mileage earned during the year.**
- Two (2) day events: the second day of a two day event where participant is unable to launder jersey (e.g. MS-Cycle to the Shore)
- A multiple day event requiring the participant to wear the "event" jersey on certain days. Member will only be required to wear club jersey on days allowed by the event.
- Special Event Recognition Status Jersey allowance: Registering as an NFBC Charity Ride member and rating special consideration based upon unique designation by the event itself for high financial contribution, e.g. Top Banana Jersey (MS Cycle to Shore) or some other special status such as Red Rider (Tour de Cure).
