

The DALMAC Fund - Grants By Year

The DALMAC Fund was established in 1975 to promote bicycling in Michigan. Half of the profit from the annual Dick Allen Lansing to Mackinaw bicycle ride, DALMAC, is set aside as the DALMAC Fund.

The DALMAC Fund goals:

1. Improve the bicycling environment in Michigan
2. Expand bicycling in Michigan
3. Promote good will towards bicycling in the community
4. Increase bicycle safety

Grant requests will be evaluated on meeting the 4 goals, as well as,

1. The amount requested is reasonable
2. TCBA is comfortable funding the request
3. The request has local support
4. Funding one year does not guarantee funding in future years
5. Facility requests will be commented on by the Michigan Trails and Greenways Alliance

Typical grant funded requests involve,

1. Construction and design of bicycle facilities
2. Bicycle education programs
3. Bicycle promotion activities
4. Purchase of bicycles and related equipment
5. Developing bicycle routes or maps (not facilities)

The DALMAC Fund grants are awarded by the Tri-County Bicycle Association in consultation with DALMAC's founder, Dick Allen. Grant application and instructions are available at biketcba.org.
