Back Alley Bikes – (Detroit) \$1,500 toward a \$4,323 summer youth bike ride program in conjunction with their Earn-A-Bike program. Meg Marotte presented.

Detroit Bike Share- \$5,000 toward a \$60,000 accessibility recruitment program to broaden ridership for Detroit's new bike share project. (Assisted by PEAC staff) Lisa Nuskowski presented.

Detroit Greenways Coalition- \$2,000 toward a \$10,000 bicycle map printing project for Detroit. Other funds used to develop the maps. Todd Scott presented.

Friends of Ingham County Parks - \$5,000 towards a \$17,200 project to improve Burchfield Park mountain bike trails and way finding signs. (\$1,000 DALMAC Fund, \$4,000 TCBA general funds) Jeff Potter, Jeff Gehl, Anne Grofvert and Tim Morgan presented.

Kalamazoo Bicycle Club- \$3,000 towards a \$10,000 project educating the public on the 5' passing ordinances passed by the cities of Kalamazoo and Portage. Paul Wells presented.

Kids Repair Program of Lansing - \$8,000 in TCBA General Funds toward their \$13,189 Youth Bicycle Education program. Dave Meade presented.

Mid-MEAC- \$2,249 towards a \$5,040 project to operate the Valet Bike Parking project in the Lansing area.

Munising Bay Trail Network- \$6,000 towards an \$11,145 project to purchase a trailer for storing and hauling 22 youth mountain bikes. Lynn Kentuer presented.
