LODGING OPTIONS:

1. Cottages: The TWO cottages reserved have two bedrooms (all split king beds), a living room, kitchen, and are located within walking distance of the Stateside Hotel and the slopes, with shuttle buses every few minutes. Cottages are within numbers 4778 – 4785
2. Stateside Hotel: 2 Queens, or 1 King & a sleeper sofa per room. Double occupancy (per bedroom) is assumed.
3. We'll try to accommodate everyone's rooming preferences.

BUS - CANCELLED:

- Due to low signup so far, we had to return almost ½ of the lodging. It is no longer possible to have a bus and no need for the box lunch for the return home.
