Here is some of the latest "Go Fast" information from past National winners:

Start with mast straight up and down. As the wind comes up, drop back one to two lengths. Also, keep the side stays tight. With heavy wind use a lot of vang, both up wind and down wind. Do not oversheet while tacking. Always sail the boat flat. Steer first, then ease the main.

Some problems that are showing up:

Persons with black masts are having trouble with the stainless rivets pulling out of the spreader guides. Check your boats and if these are loose, Melges is now putting a stainless strip from one side to the other in front. If you do this yourself, be sure to use 3/16 stainless pop rivets. Melges will have these straps and the tools to repair these boats in Atlanta at no cost.

See you all in Atlanta at Lake Lanier for the National. Racing dates are Friday, September 30, Saturday, October 1, and Sunday, October 2. Weigh in Thursday and Friday morning, early.
