'94 MC MASTERS REGATTA

August 25-27, 1994 Fleet 10 Grand Rapids YC, MI

Grand Rapids Yacht Club will host the 1994 IMCCSRA Masters Regatta August 25-27 on beautiful Reeds Lake from the newly expanded and redecorated club. Registration will begin on Wednesday, August 24th from 5-9 PM. Beer and championship-grade chili will be available.

Racing will begin on Thursday morning with one race before lunch and two after lunch. The same schedule will be sailed on Friday with a concluding race on Saturday morning with all races being scored. Excellent food will be served. Racing will be scored in two divisions; Masters (50-59 years) and Grand Masters (60 and over). Five trophies will be awarded in each division with the overall regatta winner receiving a blazer with an embroidered IMCCSRA insignia on the pocket.

The regatta is open to IMCCSRA members at least 50 years of age on or before August 25. A separate mailing will be sent to all Master IMCCSRA members with additional details and an entry form. The entry fee of \$65 includes registration, free beer and pop, skipper's tee shirt, continental breakfasts, heavy hors d'oeuvres Thursday evening, skipper's dinner Friday evening.
