Official Puff Watcher's Manual

#1 SILVER FIZZLER

This puff skips across the water and glistens as it comes toward you but just as you are ready for it, it never hits but fizzes away.

#3 BLACK WHAMMY

This puff is very fast and extreme caution has to be used when it is near.

#6 GREEN SLUDGE

Reportedly only found on Pewaukee Lake. This puff moves across the water but is not noticed because of the high surface tension of the water.

#7 LIFTING GOTCHA!

A menace to all port tack boats. A port boat trying to cross a starboard boat when the starboard lifts and yells, "I gotcha!"

#8 SLEAKER SNEAKER

A puff that bounds out of the high hills near the shore line, bouncing right over you. Often seen on Lake Lotawana, Missouri and on Reeds Lake, Grand Rapids, Michigan

#9 JUDGES PANIC

It is a dead calm and the Judges see one puff come down the lake and they shoot the five minute gun. Seen on Okauchee Lake by Judge Don Wileque.

#10 THE TEXAS DRIFTER

Seen at the ILYA in 1967, as the swells were 6 feet high and the winds blew a modest 35 mph. Bob Chilton of Dallas was bored.

#11 PARENT'S (or SPOUSE'S) PUFF

This is a group of puffs the parents or spouse on shore see during the race and when you get to shore they ask, "Why weren't you on the other side of the lake where the wind was?"

#14 JIMMY DURANTE PUFF

Your going fast, heading for the top mark and it hits you on the nose. Submitted by D. Keck.
