Summary: Regatta had great weather with four races sailed in challenging winds of 10-20+ mph.

Race #3 scheduled for Saturday morning was cancelled due to too much winds — gusts over 30 mph.

Dave Mott, who finished 11th in the recent MC Nationals, had four bullets to run away with the regatta. Top Masters honors went to Tran Alfrey. Pam Bradshaw in fourteenth place won the top Female place while her husband Mike finished second.

Twenty-eight boats registered and twenty-six sailed. Other fleets in the regatta: Cs, M16, X and Lasers — 58 boats total (including MCs).

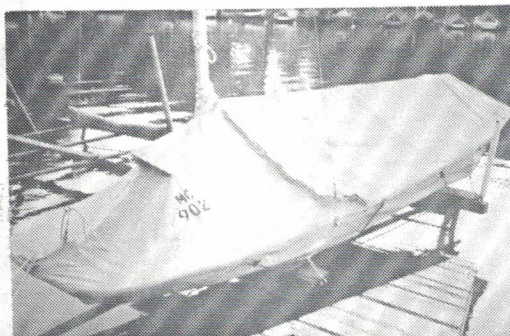

TRAILING-MOORING "T-M" - Fits flat over deck for trailing or backyard storage and will fit with mast up. Low profile cover so not full enough to fit over boom attached to gooseneck and in crutch. Has elastic shock cord in hem, tie-town points, #10 nylon zipper, mast collar, stand-up flaps that snap around stavs. Polyester Army Duck **\$352**

BOTTOM COVER - Special flannel-lined waterproof grey canvas with drain hole and elastic shock cord in hem which hangs on to peripheral of deck. Covers entire bottom and sides and bow and transom..... **\$286**
