

1999 Rebel Rouser

April 23-24, 1999

Saturday saw a standard westerly wind fill in under beautifully sunny skies and we sailed the first of five windward-leeward, mid-course start/finish line races. This race belonged to Pete Comfort.

After lunch we sailed in a very light (sometimes it seemed zero) breeze. Tommy Harken outlasted everyone for the win. By the time of the 3rd race of the day, the wind freshened to 10-12 and we enjoyed a bit more time on the high side. Greg Gondran claimed first place.

The second race of the day features a battle for first place with Tommy Harken taking the finishing horn.

Ted Keller, with wife/crew Amy's help on Sunday, put together a winning combination of finishes to win the regatta. Second place had to be determined by tie-breaker between South Carolinians Tommy Harken and Lenny Krawcheck. Lenny also topped the other Masters. Willi Lenkeit captured Grand Master honors, and Curt Bradley won the Megamasters trophy.

Stan Stanton was awarded the Junior Tro-

phy (having inadvertently checked the Junior box). After a quick conference the Regatta Chairman reasoned Stan won the trophy as the "newest, thus youngest member of IMCCSRA." Trophies were beautifully molded models of the MC on a plaque crafted by John Adams.
