



## Supervision of School Age Children in Day Care

NYS Regulations

416.8 (b) (5)

417.8 (b) (5) With the written permission of the parents, a program may allow school-aged children to participate in activities outside the direct supervision of a caregiver. Such activities must occur on the premises of the family (group) day care home. The caregiver must visually check such children every 15 minutes.

413.2 (v) School-aged child means a child under 13 years of age who is enrolled in kindergarten or a higher grade.
