Issue Teams:

Voting Methods: looks at voting methods, including alternatives to the current system of plurality voting, or "winner-take-all".

Health Care: current focus is on behavioral health, and tracking developments in overall health care access.

Campaign Finance/Money in Politics: follows the influence of money in politics and proposals for campaign finance reform.

Social Policy: issues are immigration and rights of non-citizens, meeting basic human needs (including living wage), and equality of opportunity.

Schools: analyzes ballot issue proposals and issues in the Boulder Valley and St. Vrain Valley School districts.
