

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

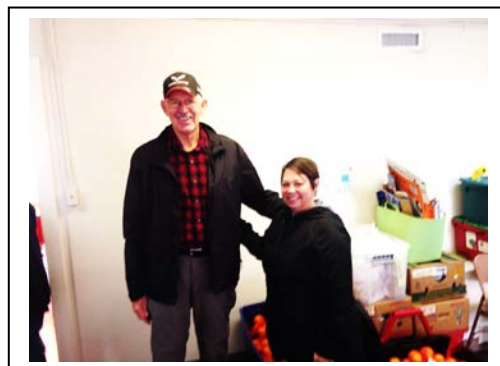

BACON JALAPENO CORN DIP



Ah, New Year's Eve – that wonderful end to holiday over-indulgence. My favorite way to soak in maximum calories before the Resolutions kick in is to switch from the sugar-filled treats of Christmas to the ooey, gooey yum of a great dip. Ingredients:

- 2 11-oz cans Mexicorn
- 1 can supersweet yellow and white corn
- ¾ cup cooked crumbled bacon
- 3 jalapenos finely chopped, seeds and stems removed
- 2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 cup mayo
- ¼ tsp garlic powder
- salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 375F
 - Grease sides and bottom of 9x9 dish generously with butter
 - In large bowl, combine all ingredients. Mix well and transfer to 9x9 dish.
 - Bake on 375 until bubbly (about 25-30 minutes)
