NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday October 19, 2019 CBYRA # 454

Description: The Regatta will consist of up to three races to be sailed in the area of the Rappahannock River between the Norris (White Stone) bridge and Towles Point.

Rules: Racing Rules of Sailing as adopted by US Sailing (RRS/US), except as altered by the RRYC 2019 General Race Instructions and this Notice of Race.

Entry: CBYRA Standard Entry Form (available on RRYC Web Site www.rryc.org under Regattas/Commodore's Cup. For entrants without a rating, RRYC PHRF Fleet Commander or Race Committee will assign a rating. Email entry forms to Ed Johnson (toohulls@gmail.com) by October 16, after then bring them to the skipper's meeting or hand deliver to the Race Committee on the water at least 10 minutes before the first warning signal.

Sailing Instruction: The RRYC 2018 General Sailing Instructions. Available at www.rryc.org under Regattas/Commodore's Cup.

Classes: PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker (Typhoons will race as PHRF Non-Spin. Two boats are required to constitute a class. If only one boat of a PHRF class register, they will sail with the class with greater numbers. (For example, if five non-spinnaker boats and one-spinnaker boats arrive to race, the race will start with six non-spinnaker boats.) The race committee will

notify boats registered for an underrepresented class of this by radio.

Schedule: There will be a short, not mandatory, Skipper's meeting at 8:30 AM at the RRYC clubhouse. First warning signal will be at 10:30 AM. Second or subsequent races will start soon after boats have finished or time limit is reached. Time permitting; Race Committee can start the next race for a class(s) before the next class finishes. Attempt will be made to finish the last race no later than 3:30 PM.

Radio: Communications between the Race Committee and participants will be on VHF 72. **Scoring:** The Low Point System described in RRS/US Appendix A4.1 shall be used.

Awards: Trophies for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places in Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker.
