

THE STUDY

The aim of this study is to explore the perceptions of pediatric occupational therapists regarding their knowledge of constraint-induced movement therapy (CIMT) in practice. This study will also explore how contextual variables may impact the perceptions or implementation of CIMT. Lastly, this study will investigate the barriers and enablers that influence pediatric occupational therapists use of and knowledge of CIMT.

RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS

Licensed occupational therapists

At least one year of experience

Previous knowledge on the intervention of CIMT

Currently practicing pediatric occupational therapy in the state of Missouri and surrounding states

THE PROCESS

Each participant will partake in a structured interview that will consist of 10 questions aimed to explore CIMT from an occupational therapist's perspective.

The interview will last approximately 20-30 minutes.
