



2018 IAWRP Symposium Command Track Overview

Initial Command and Control at a Water Rescue Incident

This track will assist the incident commander or first due company officer in developing and deploying resources at the scene of a water rescue incident. The course will focus on the initial actions and deployment of resources to rescue victims as well as define a size up process and report on conditions.

- The course will cover; vehicles trapped in moving water, victims trapped on mid river obstacles, recreational boating incidents, as well as planning for search operations.
- We will cover the appropriate tools and techniques to affect a rescue in multiple scenarios while developing a risk analysis of observed hazards and create a "Go no Go checklist".
- The course will use a multi- media platform with video of actual rescues to support the scenarios for the students.
