MENTORING PROGRAM 2020

The program provides mentoring for thematic group postgraduate students and ECRs (five years from conferral) without a continuing position in academia. It focuses on writing a journal article for publication. We will pair senior academics with postgraduate students and ECRs for 6-months.

The face-to-face time commitment will be approximately 6 hours, which includes 6 1-hour paper-workshopping meetings (to be conducted in person, phone, or skype/zoom).

- April Meet and greet, review a pre-prepared abstract and paper outline, journal selection, etc.
- May Review and discuss partial draft.
- June Review and discuss full draft one.
- July Review and discuss full draft two.
- August Review and discuss full draft three.
- September– Prepare for submission and peer-review.



Mentors must be at level C and above. Mentees must be either late stage Postgrads (2 years+) or ECRs (five years from conferral) without a continuing position in academia.
