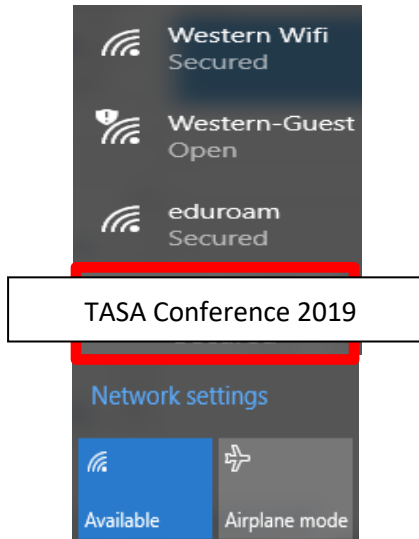

How event attendees connect to internet

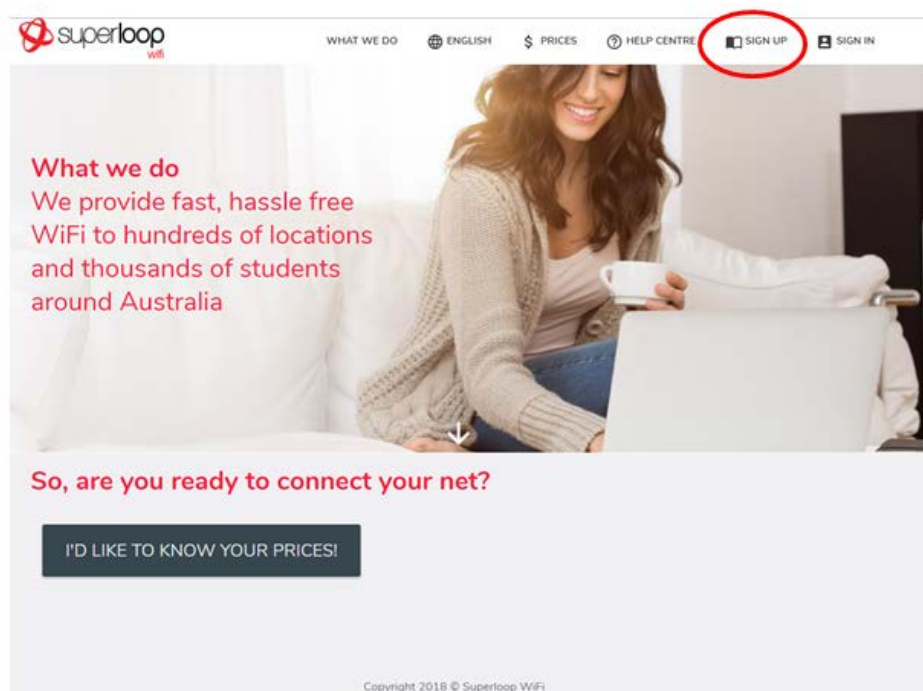
Process for event attendee to connect to event wireless network

1. Event attendee activate wireless function on device
2. Navigate to Wi-Fi network list
3. Select 'TASA Conference 2019' from list of Wi-Fi



4. Enter your password (Conf@2019) and click connect. Once Connected Networks will automatically direct you to the following URL: <https://wifi.superloop.com> If not please open any Internet browser and try to browse any website and then you will be redirected.

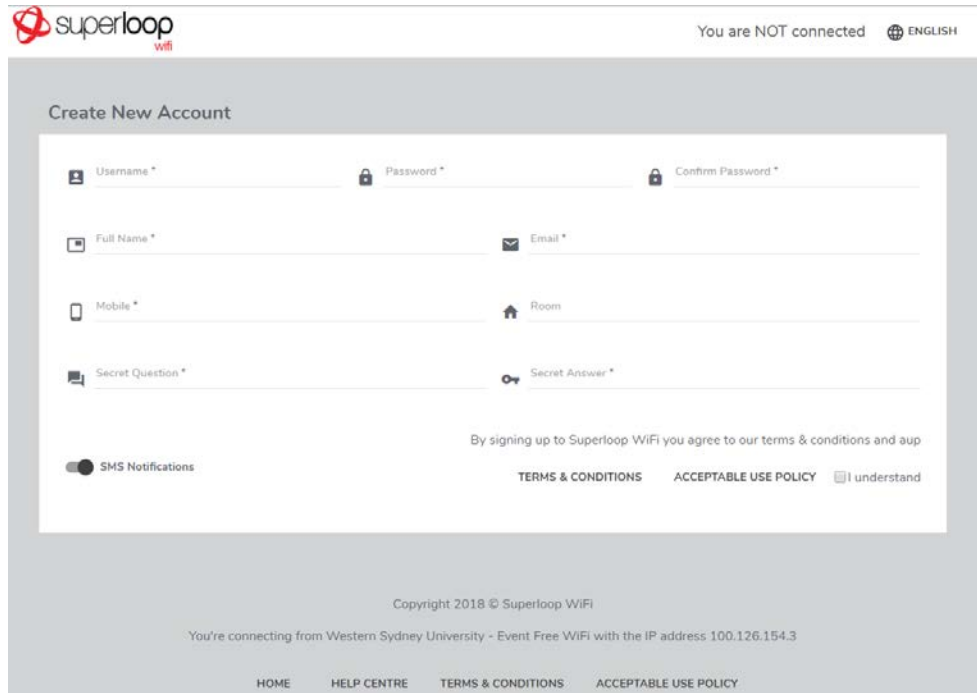
