MATERIAL LIST

Hook: Jig Hook, size 14. I'll be using FULLING MILL FM5045 (50 Degree Eye, 2X Heavy, Claw Point) ***

Bead: Silver Slotted Tungsten (7/64", 2.7mm) ***
(slotted not necessary as long as bead can go past bend in neck)

Weight: Lead wire, .10 (this is optional)

Thread: Black 6/0 or smaller (I'll be using Danville 70 Denier)

Tails: Coq de Leon fibers, several (any tail fibers are fine – pheasant, partridge, brush)

Body: Flashabou Mirage #3005 ***

Hot Spot: UTC 70, FL FIRE ORANGE or similar

Coating: Solarez Bone UV Cure or UV Loon Clear Fly Finish – Flow (any clear UV, however must be thin, dry clear, and hard) (if you use UV Loon Clear a coat of Sally Hansen Hard as Nails is recommended as final coat)
