My name is Tully Vogt and I am a Deputy Coroner with San Mateo County and a fellow DSA member. I am on the Every 15 Minutes Organization Committee for San Mateo County and we are bringing the Every 15 Minutes program to San Mateo County for the first time in San Mateo County without the assistance of Santa Clara County. Our first school presentation is tentatively scheduled to be at Sequoia High School.
