BICEPP is hosting Virtual Tabletop Exercise (VTTX) sponsored by the Emergency Management Institute (EMI). It is being provided at no charge. This VTTX is designed for organizations interested in raising awareness of cyber risk management, cyber related planning, and other issues related to cyber incident prevention, protection, and response. The scenario will focus on increasingly complex and severe cyber threats, beginning with general information on a potential security risk and culminating with the containment, eradication, and recovery from a cyber-incident.

The VTTX involves key personnel discussing simulated scenarios in an informal setting, and can be used to assess plans, policies, training, and procedures.

Exercise Goals:

1. Prepare participants for a cyber-based event affecting their organization or community.
2. Assess cybersecurity integration into an organization's all-hazards preparedness.
3. Enable participants to better coordinate their response operations with counterparts from Federal, state, local, tribal and territorial governments; private sector organizations; and non-governmental agencies.
4. Examine cybersecurity incident information sharing, escalation criteria, and related courses of action.
5. Provide a virtual, experiential education environment to increase cybersecurity awareness.
