There are 2,103 people currently hospitalized, 27% of these people are confirmed cases in the ICU and 19% are confirmed cases on ventilators.

As COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations continue to rise in the City of Los Angeles and across California, Governor Newsom issued a directive that requires the closure of additional indoor operations for certain sectors. These sectors include: Gyms and Fitness Centers, Houses of Worship, Indoor Protests, Personal Care Services (including nail salons, massage parlors and tattoo parlors, Hair Salon and Barber Shops, Malls and Offices for Non-Critical Infrastructure Sectors.

Five Drive-Through testing sites: Woodland Hills Recreation Center (West Valley), Crenshaw Christian Center, Hansen Dam, Dodger Stadium, and Lincoln Heights Two Walk-in testing sites: 102 tests administered as reported on July 14, 2020. Carbon Health and Kedren Community Health Center
 Tests administered, as reported on July 14, 2020: 13,219. **Grand total: 516,481**

Mass Care continues to support 11 shelters, and 6 trailer expansion sites. Recreation and Park's Summer Play LA program has begun at 46 Recreation sites. www.laparks.org

Meals for Angelenos with Disabilities program continuing to provide meals to people in need in coordination with LADOT, Mayor's Office, Department of Disabilities, Mass Care Branch, FNSS and our partners Khalsa Care Foundation and ACCESS Services.

Public Information Officer continues to provide updates through social media @ReadyLA, Channel 35 and Joint Information System reports. Participated in an All-City PIO table top exercise on how to prepare the Joint Information Center and PIOs to emergencies such as a wildfire while continuing with the COVID-19 Response.
