The City of Los Angeles Emergency Operations Center has been activated as a Level I since Monday, March 16, 2020 for the COVID-19 response.

Five Drive-Through testing sites: Woodland Hills Recreation Center (West Valley), Crenshaw Christian Center, Hansen Dam, Dodger Stadium, and Lincoln Heights Two Walk-in testing sites: 297 tests administered as reported on June 30, 2020. Carbon Health and Kedren Community Health Center Tests administered, as reported on June 30, 2020: 11,661. Grand total: 408,419

Mass Care continues to support 13 shelters, and 7 trailer expansion sites.

Meals for Angelenos with Disabilities program continuing to provide meals to people in need in coordination with LADOT, Mayor's Office, Department of Disabilities, Mass Care Branch, FNSS and our partners Khalsa Care Foundation and ACCESS Services.

Public Information Officer continues to provide updates through social media [@ReadyLA](#), Channel 35 and Joint Information System reports.

The City of Los Angeles aligned with the Governor's Directive and LA County Guidance.

### BOC GENERAL UPDATES

During the COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus), the Business Operations Center (BOC) has assisted the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) with providing critical items towards the response. The BOC continues conversation between our private sectors, Chamber of Commerce, Universities, NGO's and other agencies, and work with council office and Neighborhood Councils.

#### Sector/partner updates

- Working with the LA Chamber to identify critical needs within the business community. BOC is also working with Chamber is providing information and training for Business Resiliency.
- The YMCA is providing grab and go locations for their community. They have also developed free virtual programs that families can do at home.
- The American Red Cross is continuing to have Blood Drives. During the months of July –September, when you donate blood, you can receive a free anti-body test.
- The Salvation Army continues to do food delivery for the vulnerable population. They are continuing to take in donations.
- Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (Neighborhood Councils) continue to assist the City response.
- BAPS Charities and CORE Response continue to assist with the testing sites and other COVID related items.

### DONATION MANAGEMENT UPDATES

BOC is continuing to assist the COVID-19 response.
