Admission to the Pool

Membership dues must be paid in full prior to using the pool for the first time and are non-refundable. Members must show identification and sign in at the gate. Children twelve (12) and older that demonstrate swimming skills may be left without parental supervision with written permission. A permission form must be completed for non-member guests and signed by that child's parent or guardian. Children under 15 may not bring a guest without a parent present.

Guests

Members may bring guests to the pool with the use of guest passes. They are available for purchase at the snack bar. Each adult guest may come to the pool no more than 5 times per season. Members must accompany their guests at all times and are responsible for their conduct. Guest passes are not required for children under the age of 2, or adults in non-swimming attire. Guest passes will not be replaced if lost. They are only good during the year purchased. They are refundable if the pool closes due to inclement weather within one hour of arrival.

Babysitters

Members that employ a non-member babysitter may purchase a sitter's pass for the season. A member babysitting a non-member may purchase a pass for the non-member child. These are restricted passes and may only be used when accompanied by the member. Babysitters must be 15 years or older.

Swim Lessons

Group and individual swim lessons are available from certified instructors for children and adults. Swim lesson dates and times are flexible. Please see the pool manager for more information.

Swim Team

Joining the Dolphins is an excellent way for children to enhance their swimming skills. Children may join the team at any time during the swim team season. There is an annual registration fee. Practices are Monday through Friday. Children are encouraged to attend as many practices and meets as possible. Parents are required volunteer to help during home swim meets. Please contact the Swim Team Coordinator for more information.

Adult Swim

Adult swim may be called each hour in the L-Pool for no longer than ten minutes. Parents may not bring infants/toddlers in the pool. This provides children with an opportunity to go to the bathroom, rehydrate, have a snack, have sun screen reapplied, etc.

Pool Parties & Picnic Shelter Rentals

A large party table can be reserved at no charge during normal hours. The picnic shelter may be rented for a fee. Parties renting a pool for private use require a minimum of two lifeguards. For more than 50 swimmers, an additional lifeguard for every 25 swimmers is required. An hourly fee applies for each lifeguard. Private

parties must be over by 10pm. See the pool manager for more information and to make arrangements. Please make reservations at least two weeks in advance.

Pool Rules

1. Obey lifeguards at all times.
2. Proper swimming attire is required.
3. Glass of any kind is not permitted within the pool enclosure.
4. Smoking is permitted in designated areas.
5. Handguns and weapons are prohibited on the premises.
6. Only lifeguards are allowed on the lifeguard stands.
7. In the event of thunder or lightening, the pool enclosure area will be evacuated immediately to the parking lot. Lifeguards will allow members to return 30 minutes after the last instance.
8. The kiddie pool is for children up to age six (6), supervised by an adult present within its fenced area.
9. Parents are to remind their children of the importance of using the toilet facilities. Children who are not toilet trained must wear "swimmies". If a sanitary accident occurs, the pool will close for cleaning and may take several hours.
10. Non-swimming children wearing waist or arm flotation devices must be accompanied in the pool by an adult. US Coast Guard approved life vests are preferred.
11. Access to the lap/competition pool is restricted to members 18 years of age or older, swim team and swim lesson use. Children may enter this area when accompanied by a coach or swim instructor.
12. Access to deep water is permitted to those who have demonstrated sufficient ability to swim. Diving is allowed in designated deep water areas.
13. Running, horseplay, pushing, dunking, or foul language are not permitted.
14. Aggressive, intimidating, threatening, or disrespectful behavior toward pool staff, members, or guests is not permitted.
15. Spitting, spouting water, eating food, or blowing noses in the pools is prohibited.
16. Eye goggles are permitted, but may not be used while on the diving board.
17. Facemasks, snorkels, fins, balls, toys, water guns, diving or play objects are allowed in the pool at the discretion of the lifeguards. Water blasters are prohibited.
18. Toys on wheels are prohibited, including wagons, big wheels, kids vehicles, go-karts, motorized bikes, skates, roller blades, skateboards, etc., including the parking lot.
19. Cross-pool games may be played with ten (10) or less swimmers at the discretion of the lifeguards. No running dives are permitted.
20. Unauthorized presence on association property or the use of the facilities during non-operating hours constitutes trespassing. Police are authorized to apprehend and prosecute trespassers.

The operation of the pools and enforcement of the rules is under the direction of pool

management and staff. Minor infractions may result in a request that the individual sit out of the pool. More serious offenses may result in suspension of membership privileges: one day for a first offense; up to seven days for a second offense. Membership may be revoked at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
