- Please arrive at camp and check in at 1:30 pm on Monday, June 15, 2020.
- Please make the camper has eaten lunch before drop off.
- Intro to FishCamp and Orientation Slide Show begins at 2 p.m.

We would ask that all campers try to arrive around 1:30 pm to begin check in and to get situated in their respective cabins. Orientation for campers begins at 2 pm.

On the last day of camp, Friday, parents and family are invited to to attend the FishCamp graduation ceremony beginning at 10 a.m. on June 19, 2020. FishCamp graduation involves “The Test,” in which campers demonstrate things they’ve learned during the course of the week. “The Test” is followed by an awards ceremony, then lunch. We encourage families to attend the graduation ceremonies, as this is a wonderful time to encourage and support the young anglers and fly tiers. Camp will be closed after lunch.

FishCamp Includes:

- State-of-the-art walled tent cabins nestled in grove of pine trees on Antelope Creek Ranch. Antelope Creek Ranch is located in the shadows of Mount Shasta about 40 minutes northeast of the town of Weed, Calif. It is a privately leased ranch with nearly two miles of stream and two lakes teeming with fish.
- All meals are provided, beginning with dinner Monday and through lunch on the last day of camp (Friday). We serve three savory, healthy meals each day, with plenty of snacks in between. Each meal has a few options for picky diets, but if you have very specific needs or dietary concerns, please give us a call well in advance of the week so that we can plan accordingly.
- All equipment for classes will be provided, including a variety of fly rods, reels, lines, leader, tippet, and flies.
- Each camper will receive a FishCamp t-shirt, hat, and a fanny pack with fly fishing tools and several flies.
- Campers also receive a comprehensive notebook that will be a permanent record of all the subjects that were covered in the classes and a handy reference for future use.
